WHEN: Wednesday, March 7th: 5:30 – 7:30 PM

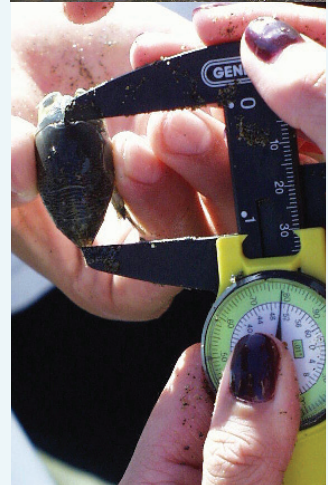
WHERE: Sanctuary Office, the Presidio, San Francisco
